ACTION:

Request Approval of a Budget Amendment Resolution (BAR) to Allocate New Mexico Department of Transportation Grant Funding in the Total Amount of \$95,000 to FY25 Parks and Open Space Revenue and Operating Budget to Support Litter Control and Beautification Efforts. BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY:

The Que Linda Beautification Program, established under the "Clean Highways Act" (NMSA 1978, Section 67-15-1 to -4), promotes litter control and beautification across New Mexico. This initiative enhances public spaces by encouraging local participation and collaboration with municipalities. The City of Santa Fe will play a key role in maintaining cleanliness and advancing beautification efforts.

The program focuses on the continuous removal of litter along roads and highways within Santa Fe. Upon execution of the resolution and grant agreement, funds will be allocated to several object accounts including a software expense for the purchase of ARCGIS to support project mapping and data management.

The grant will be approved by Governing Body, via resolution, in a separate action.
