- Your Comment: I am strongly against the proposal for "affordable housing" pallet shelters to be built on or near site 6, as well as many of the other proposed areas. This study seems to have only selected locations near low-mid income areas that already struggle with the poorly managed homeless, drug, and criminal activities west of St Francis Drive. Giving an opportunity for them to further spread into residential neighborhoods is a terrible idea.

Additionally, the proposal to place one of these locations at site 6 is a terrible idea, it's within 100 yards of a recovery home where individuals are trying to stay away from crime and drug use.
