# ADA ESTABLISHED PRIORITIES

The Department of Justice (DOJ) ADA Title II regulations identify four (4) priorities for accessibility compliance:

- **Priority 1: Accessible approach and entrance**
- **Priority 2: Access to goods and services**
- **Priority 3: Access to public toilet rooms**
- **Priority 4: Access to other public items**

- **Architectural Barrier Removal**
- **Accessible Services, Programs and Activities**
- **Accessible Communication**
