10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER AND WINE DURING THE**
12 **GREEN CHILE COUNTRY JAMBOREE IN THE RAILYARD PARK ON JULY 4TH, 2025,**
13 **PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION 23-6.2(C) SFCC 1987.**

14 **WHEREAS**, SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2 governs the consumption of alcohol on City
15 property; and

16 **WHEREAS**, for serving alcohol at City properties not specifically mentioned in SFCC
17 1987, Section 23-6.2(A), the ordinance requires the Governing Body to approve a resolution that
18 specifies the event, date, hours, location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be
19 served, permits, and insurance, at least thirty (30) days prior to the event; and

20 **WHEREAS**, proceeds from the Green Chile County Jamboree will support the American
21 Red Cross Disaster Relief Fund and the Forest Stewards Guild, a non-profit based in Santa Fe that
22 supports keeping forests strong, healthy, and fire-resilient; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Santa Fe Brewing Company, a local brewery, would serve beer and wine for
24 the event, promoting a local business to the community.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**

1 CITY OF SANTA FE that alcohol service during the Fourth of July Railyard Park Concert is
2 hereby approved according to the following parameters:

- 3 Event: Green Chile Country Jamboree
- 4 Date: July 4, 2025
- 5 Hours: 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.
- 6 Location: Railyard Park
- 7 Number of expected attendees: 1,500
- 8 Type of alcohol to be served: Beer and Wine
- 9 Required Permits: Public Celebration Permit
- 10 Required Insurance: Liquor Liability and General Liability insurance with
11 limits not less than \$2,000,000, per occurrence and in
12 aggregate, with the City of Santa Fe, its officials,
13 directors, employees, and agents as additional insureds on
14 a primary and noncontributory basis. Santa Fe Brewing
15 Company shall provide the City with Certificates of
16 Insurance and applicable endorsements evidencing such
17 coverage.


