**SANTA FE OPERA – 214 CAMINO DE LOS MARQUEZ
AXTON APARTMENTS REZONE
EARLY NEIGHBORHOOD NOTIFICATION MEETING NOTES**

Location: Virtual Meeting held via Zoom
Attendees: City Land Use Department Representative - Janice Biletchnikoff
Applicant Representatives - Jennifer Jenkins & Collen Gavin, JenkinsGavin, Inc.

This ENN meeting addressed the pending application to rezone the 2.5-acre property at 214 Camino de los Marquez from R-21 PUD to R-29. A presentation was given by Jennifer Jenkins of JenkinsGavin, Inc. regarding the proposal, and following the presentation, a Question & Answer session was held. The following notes capture the questions and concerns raised and the responses by the Project Team.

Questions/Comments	Responses
What will be the use of the buildings? How does it increase/affect housing for Santa Fe? What is the plan for the off season?	The Opera seeks to redevelop the site as an 83-unit apartment community to house their apprentices and interns during the Opera season. Six-month leases will be offered in the off season. The Santa Fe Opera is looking to partner with local organizations with short term housing needs, as well as making units available in the open market.
Why 83 units when the property is 2.5 acers doesn't that exceed the zoning density?	The City's affordable housing regulations, the Santa Fe Homes Program, provides a 15% density bonus to offset the financial obligation of complying with the program, either through providing set-aside units or paying a fee-in-lieu.
What will the rents be?	The off-season rental rates have not been established, but will be consistent with market rates once the project is complete.
Recommendations: Consider underground parking, due to concerns over the potential height of the buildings and the amount of asphalt; renovate the existing buildings instead of redeveloping the site; and utilize St John's College dormitories as an alternative.	
Is the site within a historic district?	No, the site is not within a designated historic

	district.
A special permit is needed for a to exceed 24 feet in building height. Were there trial runs conducted for a two-story building? Could less units be considered?	As part of the Development Plan review, the Planning Commission would have to approve a special exception to exceed 24 feet. The current concept plan includes three-story structures, which are necessary to achieve 83 units and provide the requisite parking and open space.
How will the feedback be used?	All comments and concerns will be carefully considered in collaboration with the Opera.
Who approves the zoning change?	The application will first be reviewed by the Planning Commission at a public hearing, who will make a recommendation to the City Council. The City Council will then consider the request at a subsequent public hearing and render a decision.
Where will they house the Opera apprentices during construction?	The apprentices will be in alternative housing for one summer season during the construction phase, which has not yet been identified.
Will Janice Biletnikoff be following the process and acting as an advisor?	The City Case Manager has not yet been determined, but it is likely that Janice will be assigned.
Will this be going before the Board of Adjustment?	No.
Will we have access to the Zoom recording?	Yes. Please email a request to Jennifer Jenkins.
Where is the code for maximin height?	It can be found in the code in section 14-7.2(E) Increase in Maximum height in R-21 and R-29 Districts.
Concern expressed about the transient nature of the off-season residents.

RE: Re-zoning request for the Axton Apartments, 214 Camino De Los Marquez, Santa Fe

The attached signatures represent 180 + members of the Santa Fe community who are opposed to rezoning the property at 214 Camino De Los Marquez (the Axton Apartments) from R-21 to R-29 with a special use permit that would allow 3-story structure(s) at that location. The property is located in a residential neighborhood where no structures exceed 2 stories.

We believe that these signatures (predominantly representing homeowners/residents in the surrounding neighborhood) indicate significant opposition to changes in zoning and/or exceeding the 24-foot dimensional standard (height) at the Axton Apartments. Based on the information that has been shared about the prospective project, the attached summary shows the various concerns that have been expressed via signatures on the petition.

We understand (from the ENN held by JenkinsGavin on July 30, 2024) that the Santa Fe Opera has applied for re-zoning and a special use permit to exceed 2-story height standards. Further, we understand that their application will be considered by the Planning Commission for a recommendation (as scheduling allows) before going to the governing body. We sincerely request that the attached signatures be distributed to both bodies in a timely fashion so that the perspectives and concerns of these Santa Feans can be considered before/during the hearing process.

We respectfully request that the Planning Commission and Governing Body decline the request for higher-density zoning with variance to exceed the 2-story height limit at 214 Camino de los Marquez.

NO HIGHER DENSITY REZONING

At the Axton Apartments – 214 Camino De Los Marquez

The Santa Fe Opera is applying to re-zone the Axton Apartments (from R-21 or 21 units per acre to R-29 or 29 units per acre). The existing 50-unit Axton Apartment buildings would be demolished and replaced with 83 new units (66 % increase). That would require **raising the height of the new buildings to 3 stories**. Even a zoning of R-29 would not allow for a 3rd story without a “Special Use Permit.”

If the Opera re-develops the Axton Apartments, we believe they should **be subject to the R-21 zoning and standard height limits** that have defined the character of the neighborhood.

There is no benefit to our neighborhood from this proposed rezoning.

- There would be negative impacts, but nothing about the rezoning proposal indicates that our neighborhood would see offsetting benefits.

This rezoning would NOT add to Santa Fe’s permanent housing stock.

- The people who permanently live at the Axton now have reportedly been notified they will need to move out before demolition begins.
- According to the project’s spokesperson, the replacement apartments would be occupied **entirely** by the Opera’s apprentices before and during opera season. Between opera seasons, only **temporary** rentals (up to a few months) would be allowed. (The Axton Apts. currently advertises rental availability between September and April.)

Replacing the Axton with a much larger complex would negatively affect our neighborhood’s environment and put pressure on services.

- Increased traffic: Camino De Los Marquez and Don Cubero are small residential streets with limited capacity to absorb traffic from higher density development. Don Diego already gets more through-traffic than its capacity would suggest.
- Despite the proposal’s statement that significant trees would be preserved where feasible, the conceptual plan makes it pretty clear that many or most would have to go!

A 3-STORY complex (only possible with a special use permit) would set a negative precedent for the character of our neighborhood.

- Architectural scale and character in South Capital contribute to the unique character that makes Santa Fe so appealing to so many people.
- No ADJACENT OR NEARBY property is zoned R-29, and there are **no 3-story buildings east of Don Diego** for many blocks to the north and south. Eighty-three apartment units in 3 stories would be a major departure from the scale of our historic Santa Fe neighborhood.
- The highest density residences on the street are 2-story condominiums, which have **far lower** density than R-29 (even less than R-21).
- From Don Diego to the east, and from Camino De Los Marquez northward to Paseo de Peralta, the properties in the neighborhood are 1-story homes, with a few 2-story residences mixed in.
- While 214 Camino De Los Marquez isn't in the historic district, it is within a few blocks.
- Residents and homeowners in our neighborhood have made important decisions about where we live and invest relying on the regulations that govern our neighborhood, and based on its character.

Many of us love the Santa Fe Opera. But the Opera has alternatives to radically increasing the density of this property.

- Re-developing the Axton Apartments under its existing R-21 zoning would allow for a more reasonable 20 % increase to 60 units.*
- The Opera might not be able to house all its apprentices in one location, but that isn't new.

*In exchange for paying a fee that goes to Santa Fe's *Affordable Housing Trust Fund* (in lieu of actually providing affordable housing), current rules allow developers to build 15 % more units than R-21 or R-29 zoning computes to.
