




At their March 16th meeting, the Archeological Review Committee voted to approve the partial reconnaissance report of March 1, 1989 for Case AR1-1989 at 1323 Paseo de Peralta. The recommendations for completion of the reconnaissance as shown on page 25, were also approved, with the condition that an inventory and interpretation of artifacts be provided with the complete report. The committee agreed that a grading permit could be issued.

At such time as the complete reconnaissance report is approved, an archeological clearance permit will be issued. This will allow release of the building permit, given approval of all other submittals.
