8 **A RESOLUTION**

9 **CREATING AND RATIFYING THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE.**

11 **WHEREAS**, The Governing Body recognizes that the review of certain municipal
12 actions prior to their authorization by the Governing Body is essential for the health, safety
13 and welfare of the community; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the maintenance and improvement of the streets, alleys, and highways
15 owned, controlled, maintained or operated by the City of Santa Fe is a basic function of the
16 City of Santa Fe which effects public safety; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body recognizes public concerns exist regarding daily
18 operations of the City of Santa Fe Police and Fire Departments; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body recognizes the need to provide the City of
20 Santa Fe Police and Fire Departments with public input regarding initiatives and
21 programs effecting public safety; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has adopted procedures for the formation of
23 committees, task forces and ad hoc committees in Resolution 1984-56 containing 13

1 Articles which shall hereafter be referenced parenthetically; and

2 **WHEREAS**, Resolution 1984-56 (Articles 1 and 2) requires that all committees,
3 task forces and ad hoc committees be created by resolution; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the governing body now wishes to form a task force according to
5 the prescribed procedures.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
7 THE CITY OF SANTA FE THAT:

8 The Public Safety Committee is hereby formed in accordance with Resolution
9 1984-56.

10 **NAME:** (Article 3, Section 1) The committee shall be called the Public Safety
11 Committee.

12 **PURPOSE:** (Article 3, Section 2) The Public Safety Committee shall be charged
13 with reviewing programs, initiatives, projects, construction, signage and such other
14 matters regarding the Santa Fe Police and Fire Departments operations as may require
15 public examination prior to Governing Body approval. The Public Safety Committee
16 shall also be charged with making recommendations to the Finance Committee,
17 Governing Body and such other bodies as may be required to consider public safety
18 issues.

19 **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES** (Article 3, Section 3) The Public Safety
20 Committee shall be responsible for the ten items listed in resolution 1984-56, Article 3,
21 Section 3 (A) including making recommendations to the Governing consistent with the
22 purpose provided above.

23 **MEMBERSHIP:** (Article 7) The Public Safety Committee shall consist of nine
24 members. The term of each member shall be four years. Members need not be residents
25 of the City of Santa Fe. Membership of the committee shall consist of a chairperson who

1 shall be a member of the governing body, a vice chair who shall be a citizen at large, and
2 seven other at large members.

3 OFFICERS: (Article 8) The Mayor shall appoint a member of the Governing
4 Body as the chair and the vice chair shall be designated by the chair in accordance with
5 Article 8.

6 TIME: The Public Safety Committee shall be a standing committee without limits
7 as to the time in which it must perform its work.
