Summary:

The proposed Resolution clarifies the terms of Resolution No. 2024-21 to allow Council 10517 of the Knights of Columbus (“Knights of Columbus”) to display banners celebrating Santa Fe veterans as “Santa Fe Heroes” every year, between Memorial Day and Veterans Day, with installation of the banners occurring as early as the week before Memorial Day and removal occurring up to the week after Veterans Day. Resolution No. 2024-21 approved the Knights of Columbus to display banners annually; however, the caption stated that the banner display would take place “in 2024 and 2025”, creating an inconsistency between the resolution’s caption and the resolution’s specified dates. The proposed resolution updates the caption to clarify that the approval is ongoing.

Consequences of Not Enacting Legislation:

If this legislation is not adopted, then Resolution No. 2024-21 would not be clarified to allow the Knights of Columbus to be able to display banners commemorating “Santa Fe Heroes” annually.

Conflict, Duplication, Companionship, or Relationship to Other Legislation:

This Resolution clarifies the terms of Resolution No. 2024-21 to allow the Knights of Columbus to display banners beginning the week before Memorial Day and through the week after Veterans Day, annually.

Performance and Administrative Implications:

The Land Use Director and City Attorney have previously approved of the banners to ensure the banners conform to all applicable requirements and restrictions.
