I would like to express my interest in acting as an archaeologist on the Santa Fe Archaeological Review Committee (ARC). I have experience performing archaeological investigations in New Mexico, Texas, Nebraska, Colorado, Belize, Peru, and Chile. I have been working in the state of New Mexico since 2018 and have wide-ranging experience conducting cultural resource inventories and monitoring, human burial excavation, data recovery excavation, Section 106 and 110 compliance, and National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) evaluation. One of my most significant projects was participating in the excavation of the Free Mason's cemetery in support of the construction of the La Secoya de El Castillo in Historic Downtown.

While I am relatively new in my career as an archaeologist and only listed on the List of Approved Archaeologists for the Rivers and Trails and Suburban Archaeological Review Districts, I have become well-versed in the Santa Fe Land Development Code (LDC) and the procedures of the Santa Fe ARC while working as a cultural resources specialist in the Environmental Service Departments of the Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM; 2022 to 2025) and New Mexico Gas Company (NMGC; 2025 to present). While at PNM, I took over managing all submittals to the Santa Fe ARC and ensured our construction remained in compliance with the Santa Fe LDC. In doing so, I improved the quality of our deliverables and promptly reported infractions of the Santa Fe LDC to the Santa Fe ARC. In May 2025, the Santa Fe Historic Preservation Division awarded me their Archaeology Award in recognition of my work. Since starting at NMGC, I have started taking a more hands-on approach to projects within the Santa Fe Archaeological Review Districts by monitoring projects myself, even ones that do not require archaeological clearance under the Santa Fe LDC but have the potential to impact cultural resources. This is to gain the experience required to become a listed archaeologist for the Historic Downtown Archaeological Review District.

If chosen to be a Santa Fe ARC member, I would bring a valuable perspective to the committee as someone who has worked in the utility industry. At my position with NMGC, I strive to find the balance between delivering utility services and preserving cultural resources and I would bring this perspective to the Santa Fe ARC. I believe I would be an asset to the Santa Fe ARC, as I am familiar with how utility projects are performed and the impacts they have on archaeological and historic resources. Further, with the installation of fiber optic internet within the City of Santa Fe, there will be an influx of utility mainline extensions requiring archaeological clearances which I will be well-equipped to review.
