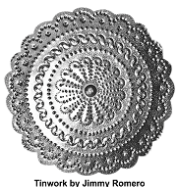

- Launch COHS Highschool Program for adults.

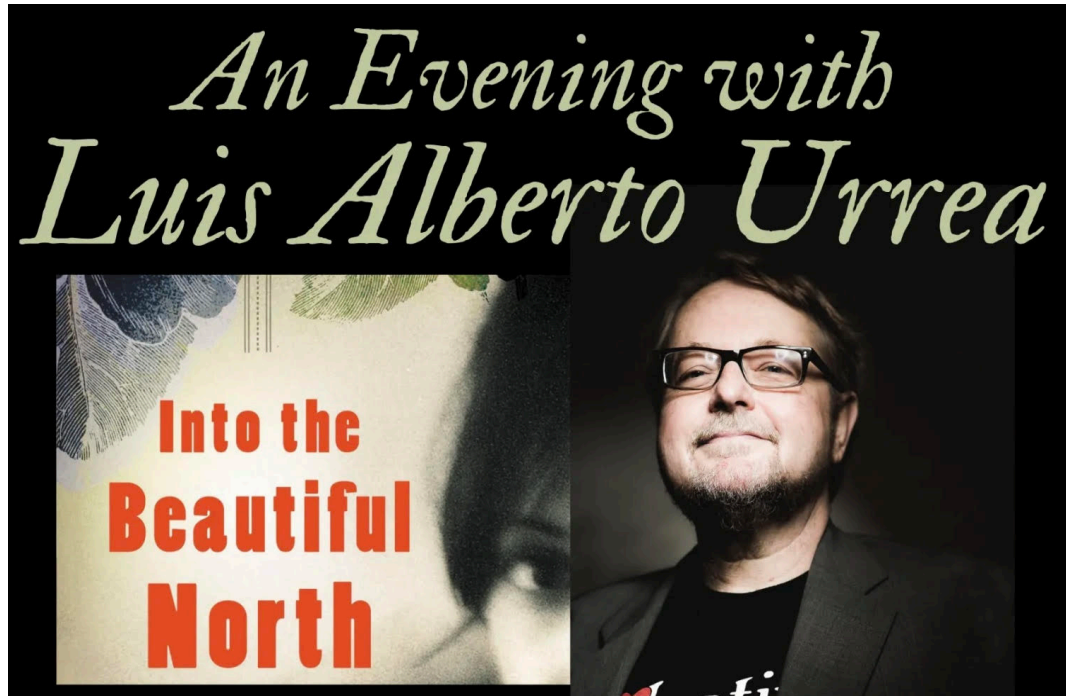

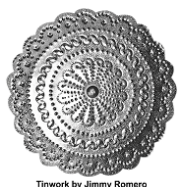


Sora/SFPS /Santa Fe Public Library Partnership:

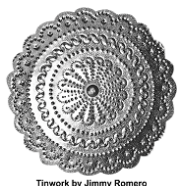

Vaccination and Bike Event

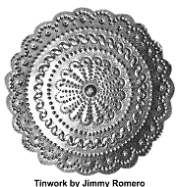

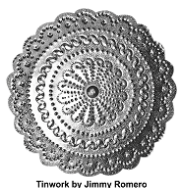

Library Phased Reopening Plan

Library Buildings will reopen July 7

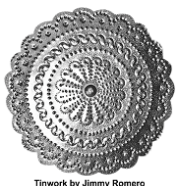
Libraries will open to in-person browsing, holds pick up and computer use limited to one hour.

- Facilities have been prepared for Covid-safe practices, plexi barriers, distancing, and limited seating are in place.
- Public Meeting Room and Study Rooms will become available in a subsequent phase.
- Outdoor programming will continue throughout the summer.
- Virtual programming, WiFi Hotspots and Laptops will continue.
- Curbside service will continue for those who need or request the service.
