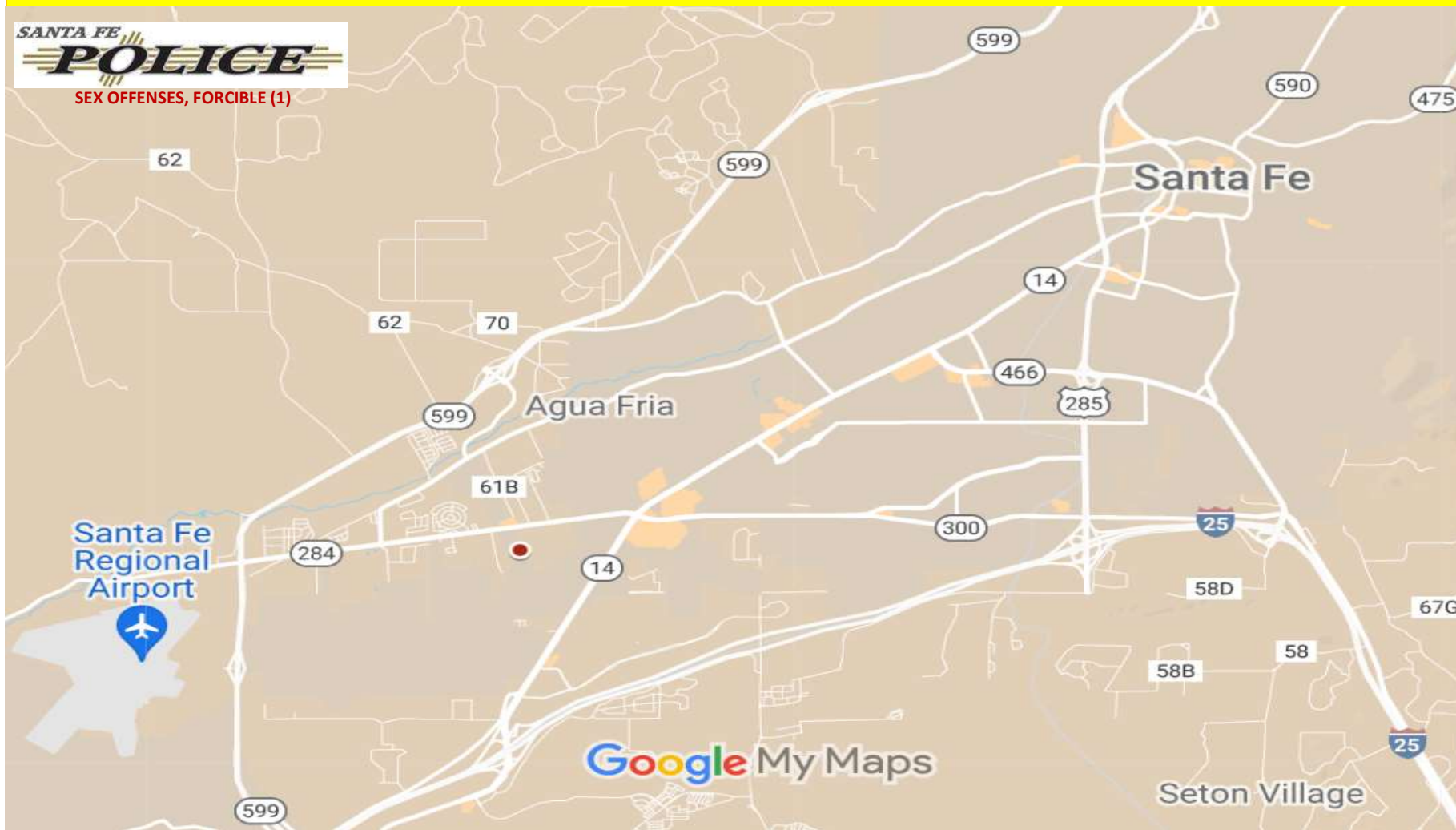

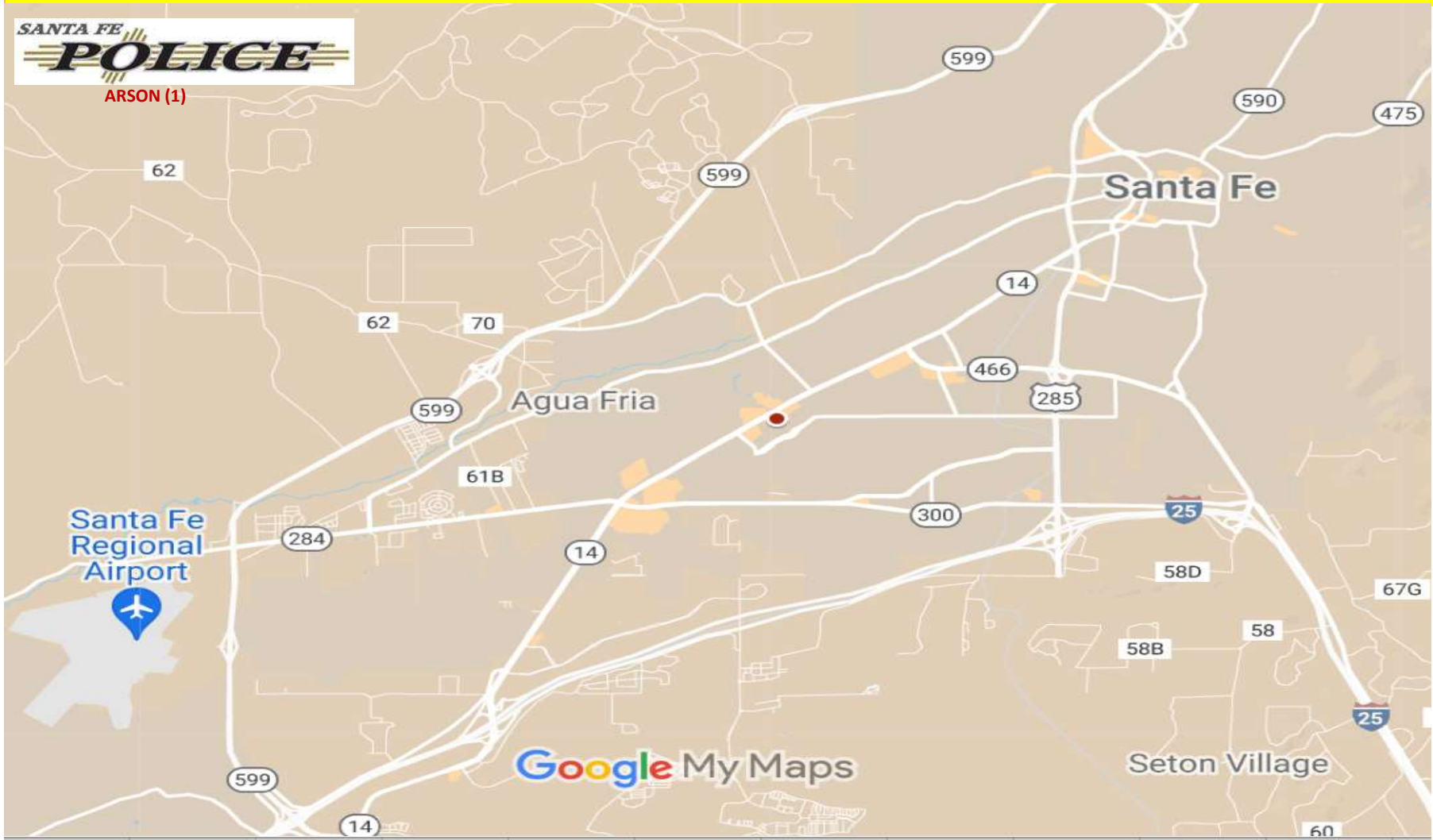

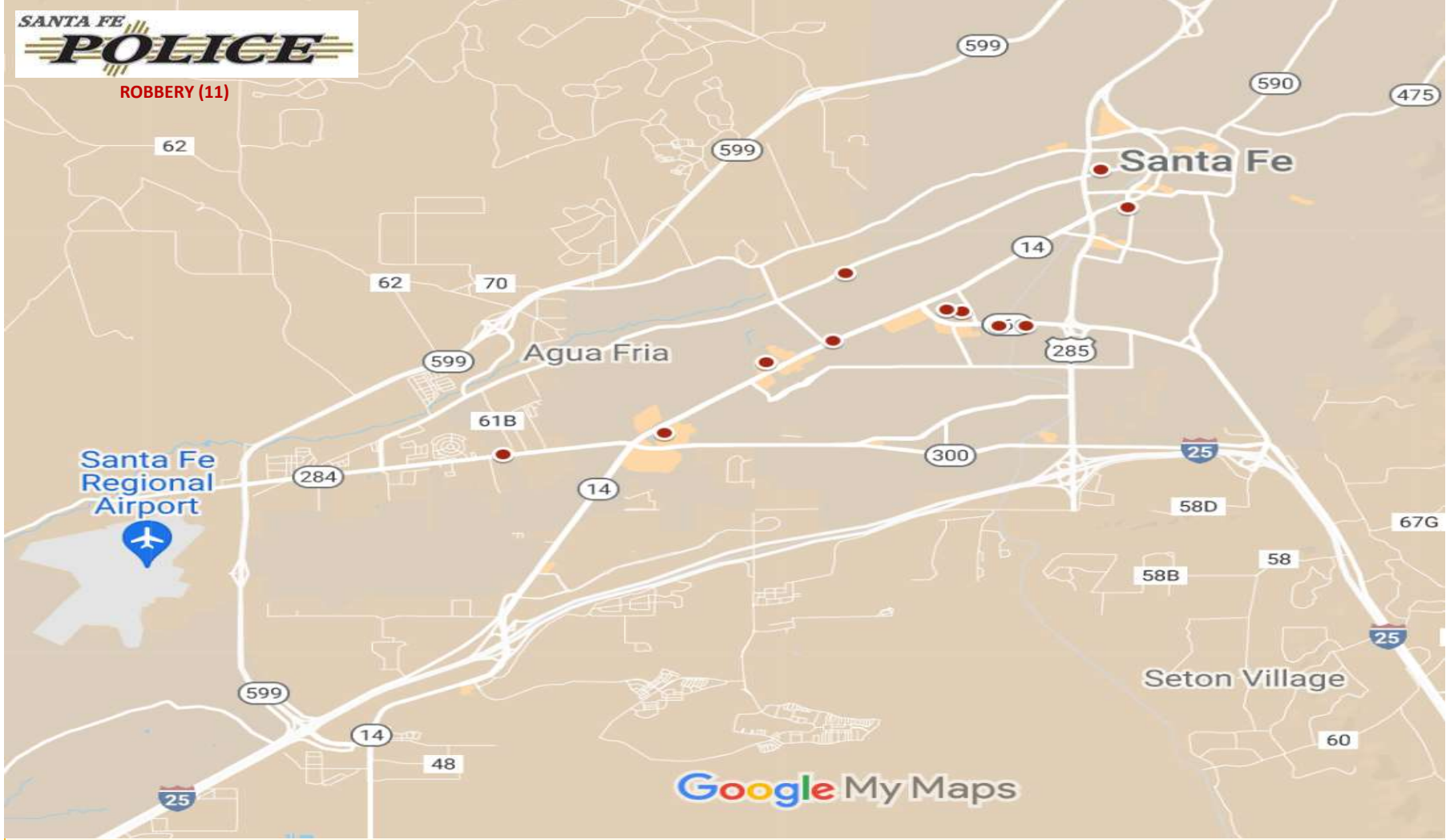
SEX OFFENSES, FORCIBLE (1)

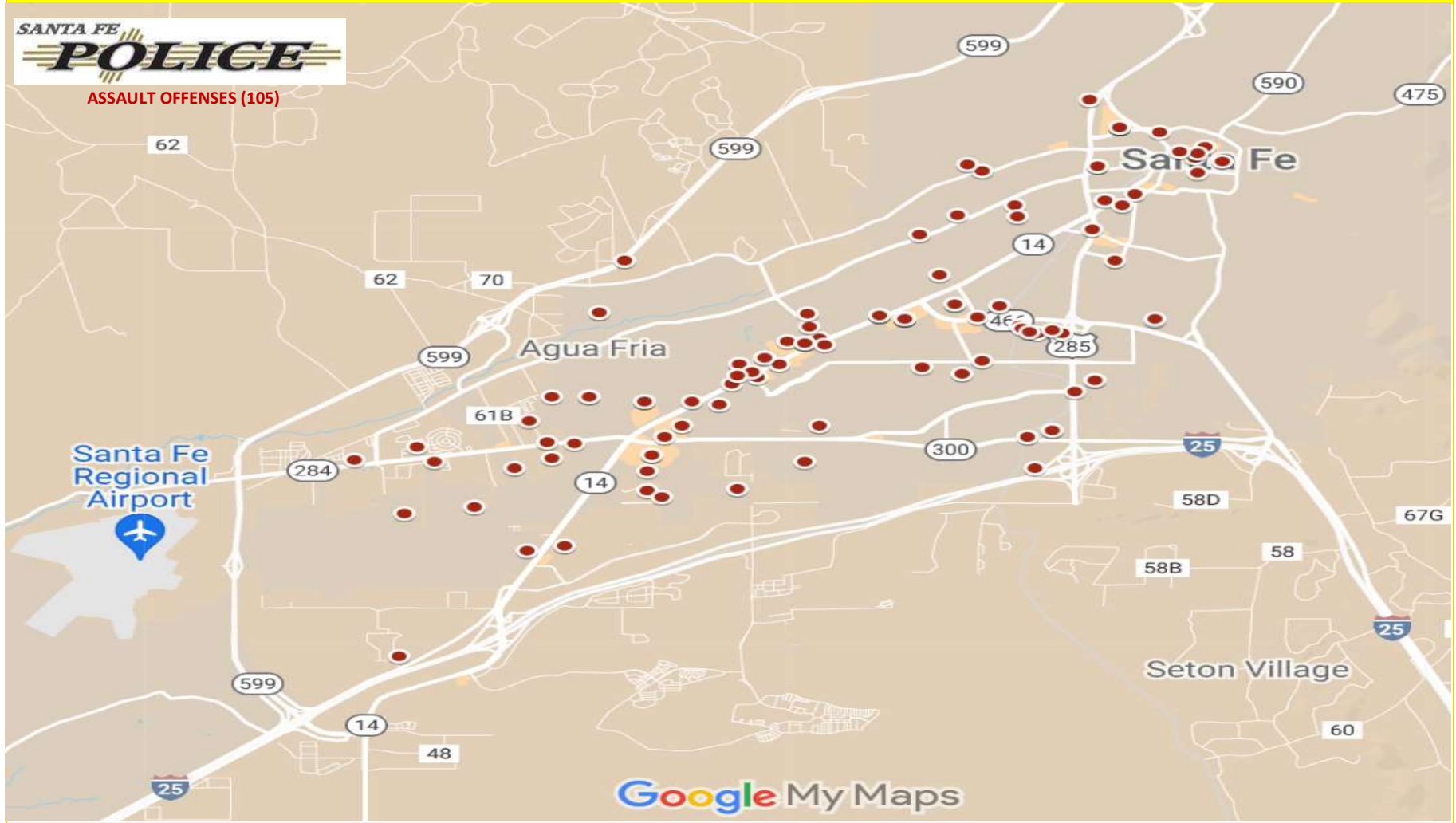

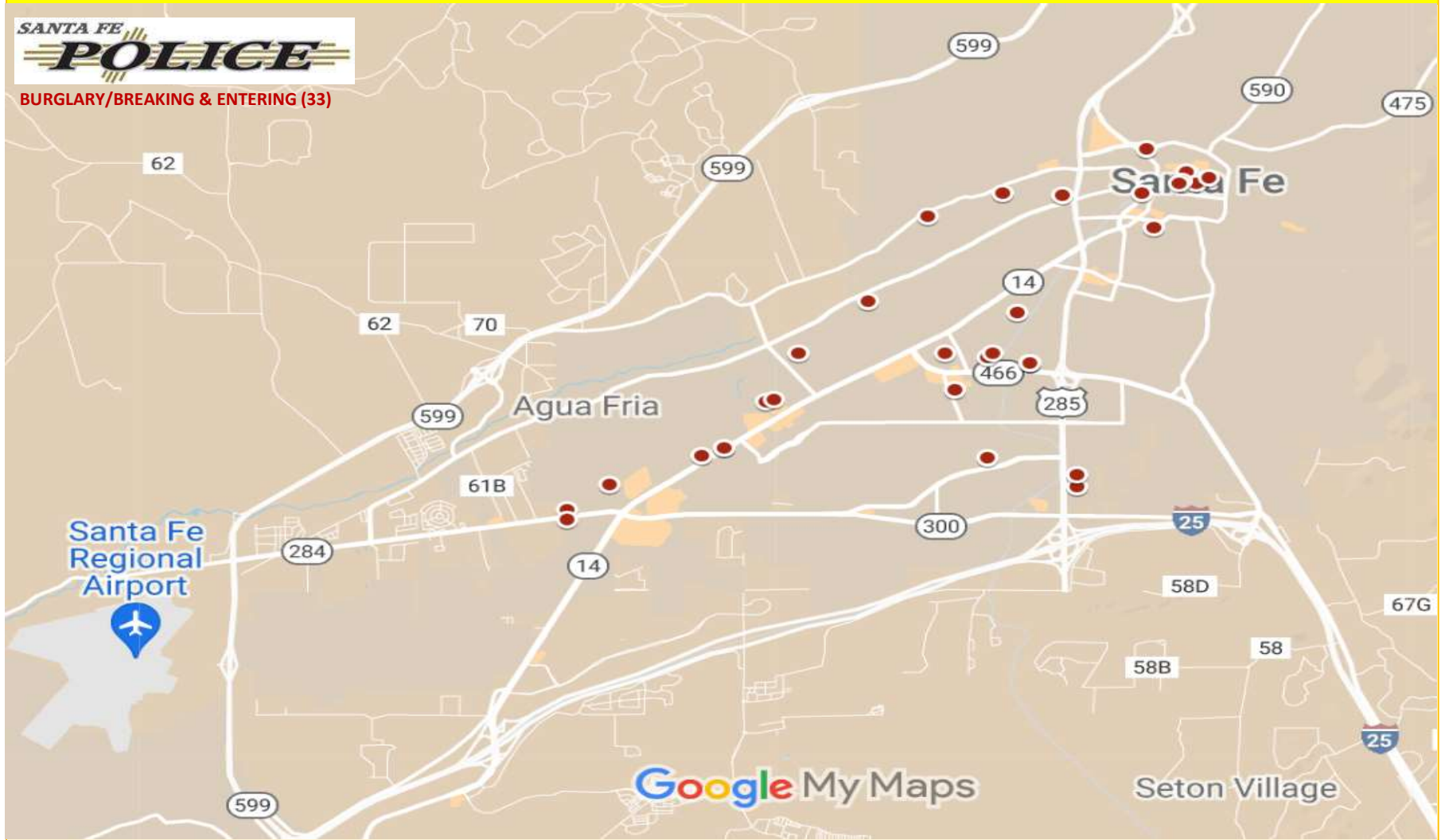
ASSAULT OFFENSES (105)

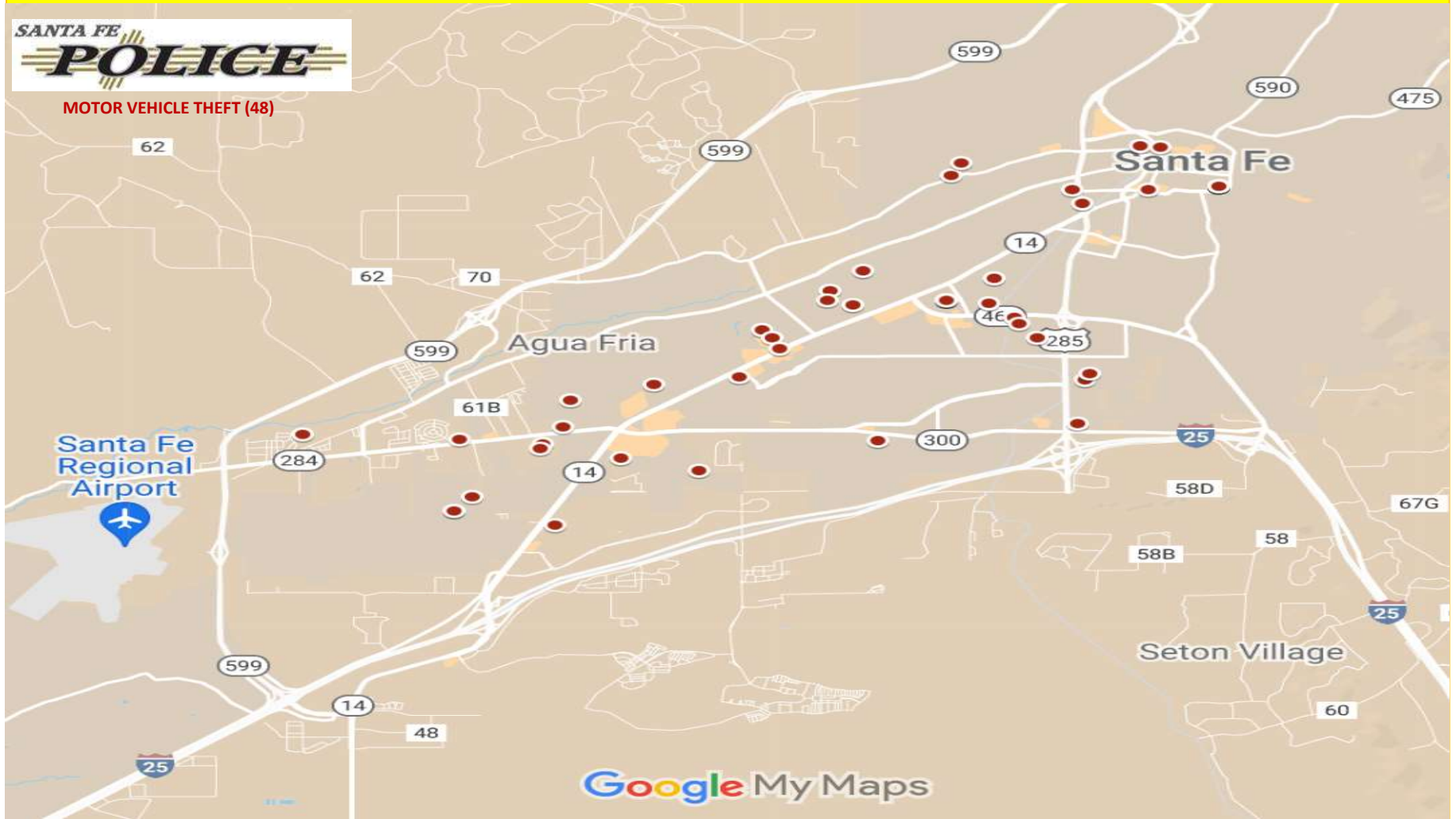
BURGLARY/BREAKING & ENTERING (33)

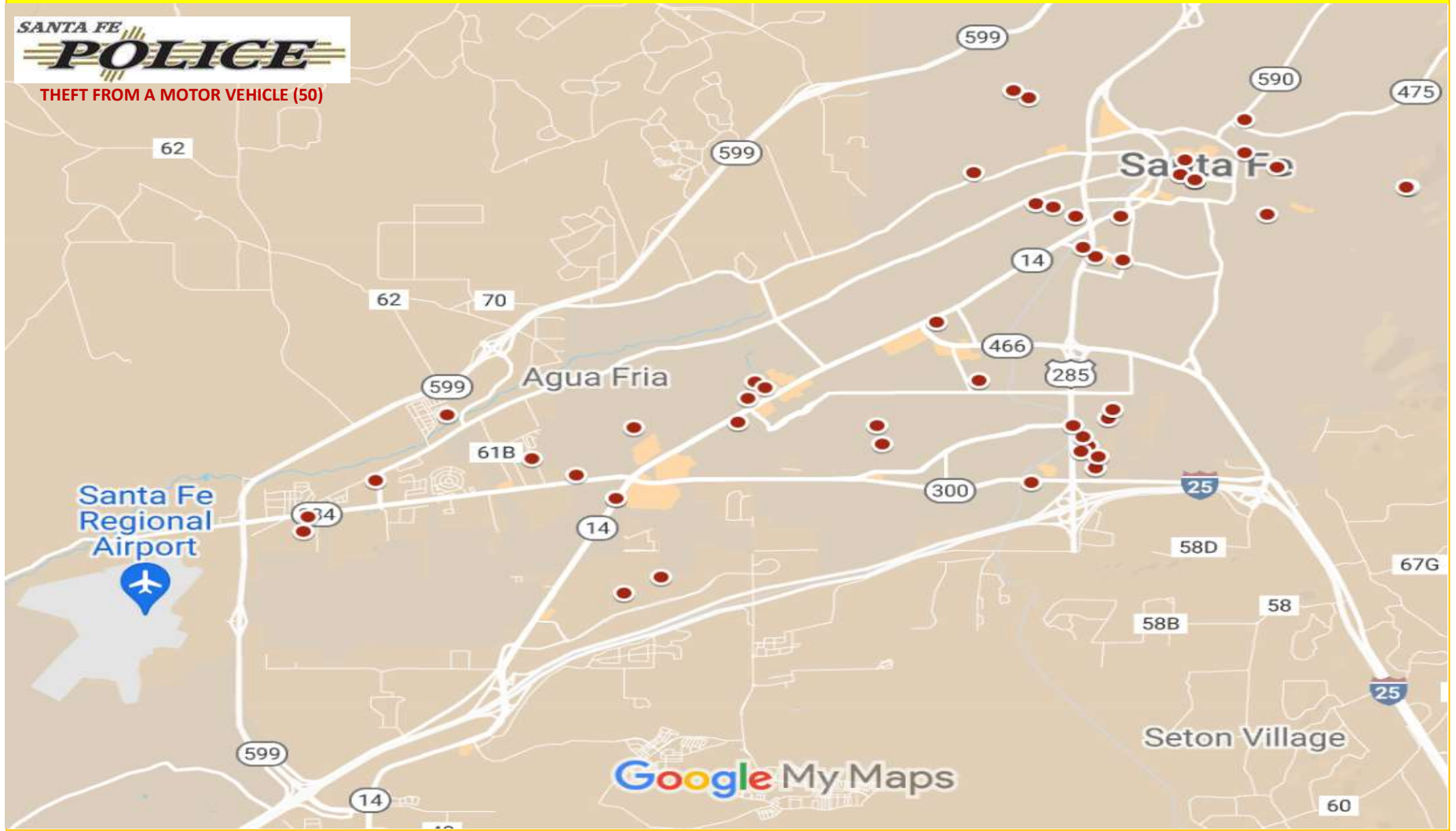
MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT (48)

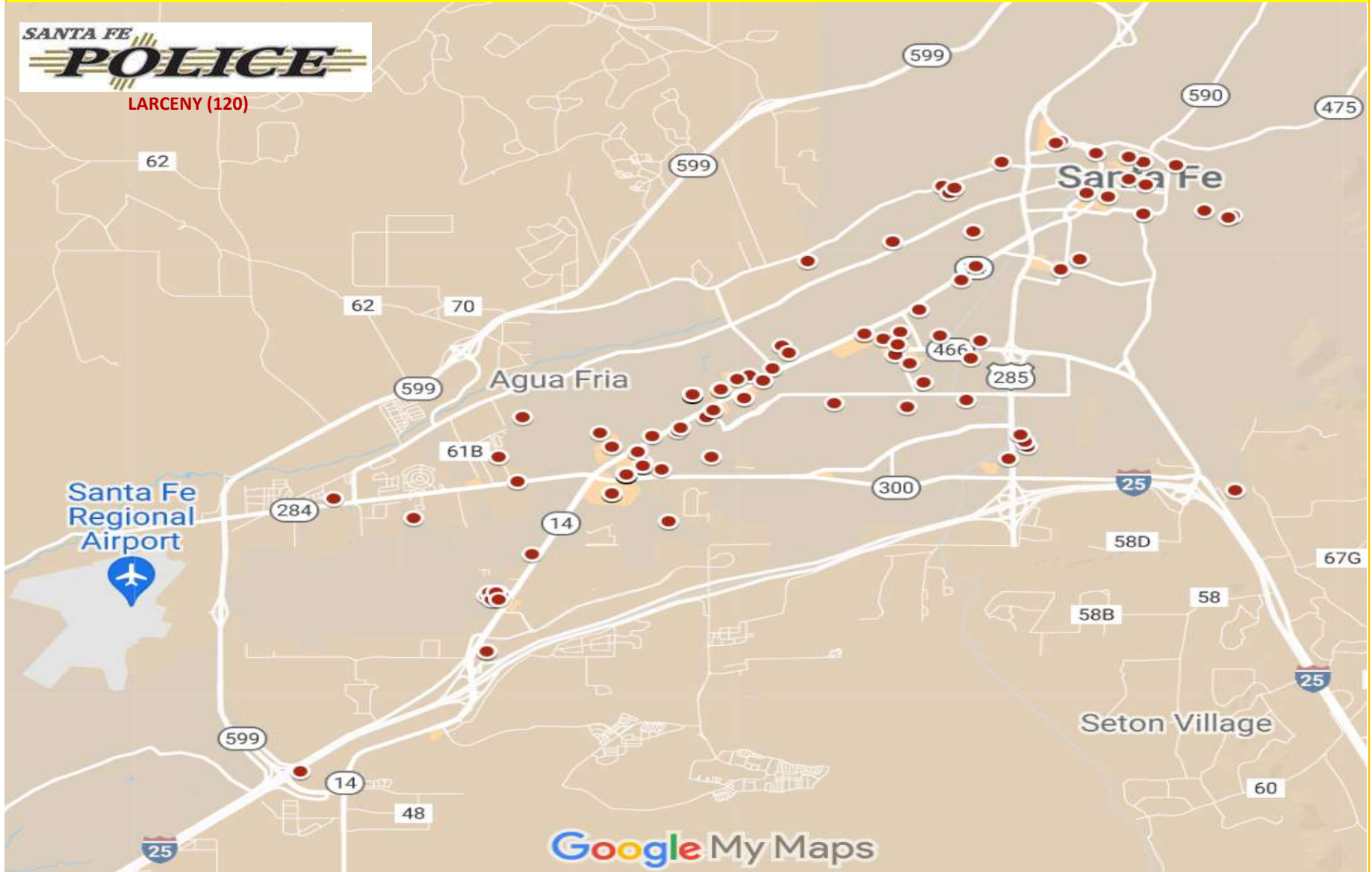
THEFT FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE (50)
