Downtown (Sheridan) Transit Center

## **PROJECT ADDRESS**

Sheridan Avenue between Palace Avenue and Marcy Street

## **DESCRIPTION**

Sheridan Transit Center is the downtown hub for pick-up and drop-off for bus riders on both the Santa Fe Trails buses and the RTD bus. It is the drop-off point for individuals that ride the Rail Runner and take the Santa Fe Pick-Up to the plaza area. It is an essential transit location for locals and tourists alike. The need to upgrade the appearance and usability of the transit center was the impetus for applying for the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) grant for a redesign of the center. The details of the design are provided in this document. The improvements will include the following items:

- • Realignment of bus lanes and repaving of Sheridan Street
- • Widening of the sidewalk area (from seven feet at widest area to 20 feet at widest)
- • Walkways to be paved with brick
- • Installation of trees and tree wells with steel grates within the sidewalk area
- • New curb
- • New bus shelters
- • Lighting
- • The existing electronic information kiosk is to be removed
