5. COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC

Louis Uljee, tourist from Amsterdam, Netherlands
Observations bicycling in Santa Fe:

- 1) If there is a need to put up a sign to "Slow Down" then the design of our streets are wrong.
- 2) No protection for bicyclists in our thoroughfares.
- 3) To increase bicycling, reduce park spaces for cars.
- 4) Political will is needed.
- 5) Santa Fe has perfect weather for bicycling and yet, very few people bicycles.
- 6) Safety comes in numbers. Don't bicycle on sidewalks – it is not safe. Need to bicycle on the road.

Sid Redner, former BPAC Member representing District 1
Brought up to BPAC attention that the bike lanes disappeared on Route 14 (northbound
