## LIQUOR LICENSE USE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into as of January 20th, 2026 (the "Effective Date"), by and between:

**Dinner for Two LLC** (an New Mexico limited liability company) 106 N Guadalupe ("Licensor" or "License Holder")

and

**Barnes Holdings LLC** (an New Mexico limited liability company) 2019 Galisteo Ste G } ("Licensee" or "User")

### Recitals

WHEREAS, Licensor is the holder of a valid New Mexico Dispenser's liquor license (the "License"), issued by the New Mexico Alcoholic Beverage Control Division;

WHEREAS, Licensee desires to serve alcoholic beverages at a private event on February 14, 2026, at the premises located at 125 E Palace Ave, Santa Fe, NM

WHEREAS, the parties wish to document the limited, one-day permission for Licensee to operate under Licensor's License for said event, subject to all applicable laws and the Licensor obtaining necessary temporary permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Grant of Limited Use** Licensor hereby grants Licensee a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable right to use the privileges of the License solely for the service and dispensing of alcoholic beverages by the drink at the Event described below, and for no other purpose.
2. **Event Details**
  - o Date: February 14, 2026
  - o Location: 125 E Palace Ave, [City], New Mexico
  - o Hours of alcohol service: 7:00pm -11:00pm
  - o Type of event: public Valentines day. The License privileges may only be exercised in strict compliance with all New Mexico liquor laws, ABC rules, and any conditions of a Special Dispenser's Permit.
3. **Compensation** In consideration for this limited use permission, Licensee shall pay Licensor the sum of **One Dollar (\$1.00)**, payable upon execution of this Agreement. This nominal amount constitutes the full and complete compensation.
4. **Responsibilities**
  - o **Licensor** shall: (a) remain the responsible license holder; (b) apply for and obtain any required Special Dispenser's Permit or other approvals from the New Mexico ABC

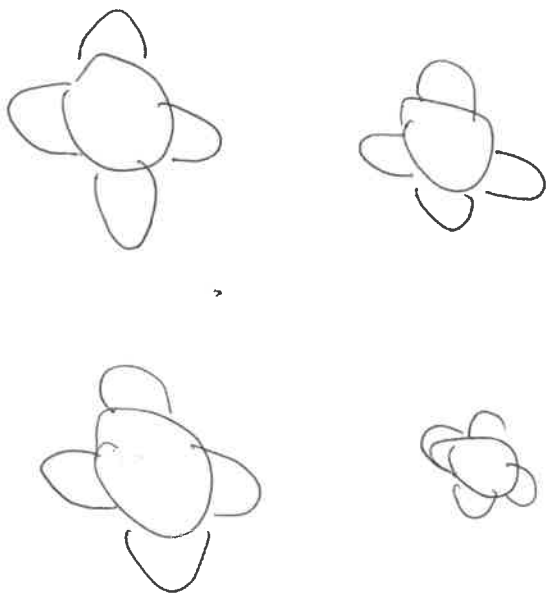

## **60-6B-10. Locations near church or school; restrictions on licensing.**

No license shall be issued by the director for the sale of alcoholic beverages at a licensed premises where alcoholic beverages were not sold prior to July 1, 1981 that is within three hundred feet of a church or school. A license may be granted for a proposed licensed premises if the owner or lessee has, prior to establishment of a church or school located within three hundred feet of the proposed licensed premises, applied for, been granted and maintained a valid building permit for the construction or renovation of the proposed licensed premises and has filed on a form prescribed by the director a notice of intention to apply for transfer of a license to the proposed licensed premises. A license may be granted for a proposed licensed premises if a person has obtained a waiver from a local option district governing body for the proposed licensed premises. A license may be granted for a proposed licensed premises if a person has obtained a restaurant A license or a restaurant B license pursuant to Section **60-6A-4** NMSA 1978. For the purposes of this section, all measurements taken in order to determine the location of licensed premises in relation to churches or schools shall be the straight line distance from the property line of the licensed premises to the property line of the church or school. This provision shall not apply to a church that has been designated as a historical site by the cultural properties review committee and that does not have a regular congregation.
