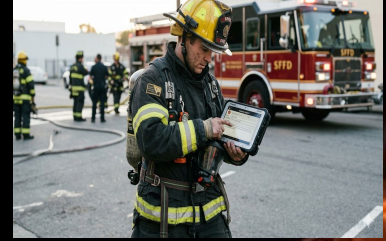

Utilizing Artificial Intelligence for FIRE and EMS Operations

AI in DOCUMENTATION



- **STREAMLINE DATA ENTRY**
 - Analyzes narrative inputs and immediately suggests structured data, significantly reducing the amount of clicking and typing required by FIRE and EMS crews.
- **INSTANT IMAGE RECOGNITION**
 - Crews simply snap photos of face sheets, handwritten notes, or pill bottles. AI extract crucial info and inputs into the report.
- **SEAMLESS FORM FILLS**
 - Using voice dictation or images. AI organizes the info and inputs directly into the report.

AI in WILDFIRE CAMERAS



- **Scale and Visibility**
 - AI-powered camera networks utilize high-definition optics to conduct continuous 360-degree sweeps. These cameras can detect visual anomalies up to 60 miles away during a clear day and 120 miles away at night.
- **Direct Alerts to First Responders**
 - Alerting first responders faster than 911 calls over 30% of the time.
 - Actionable Intelligence.
- **Real time Resource Allocation**
 - Allowing proper resource allocation allows crews to fight fire offensively instead of defensively.

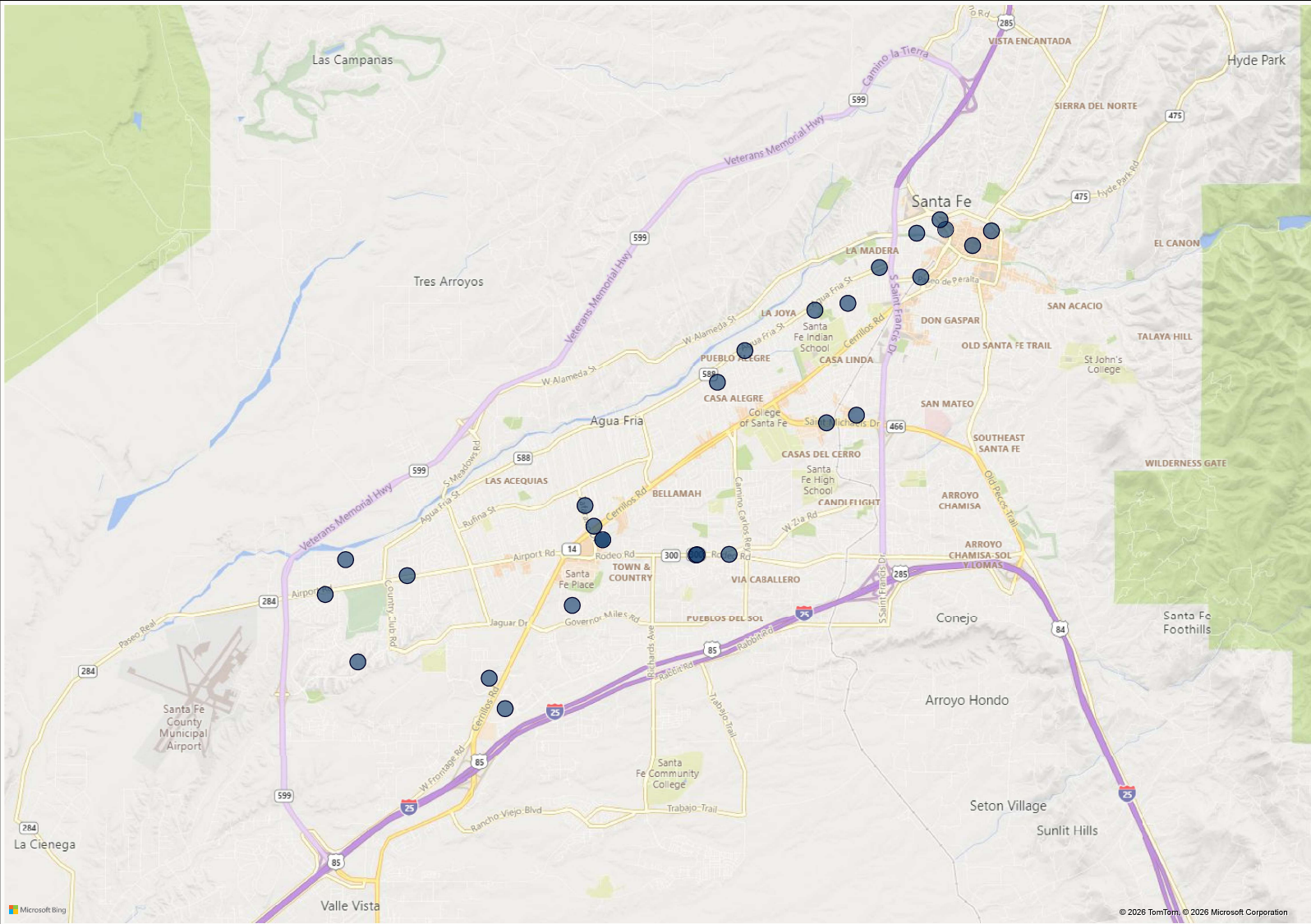

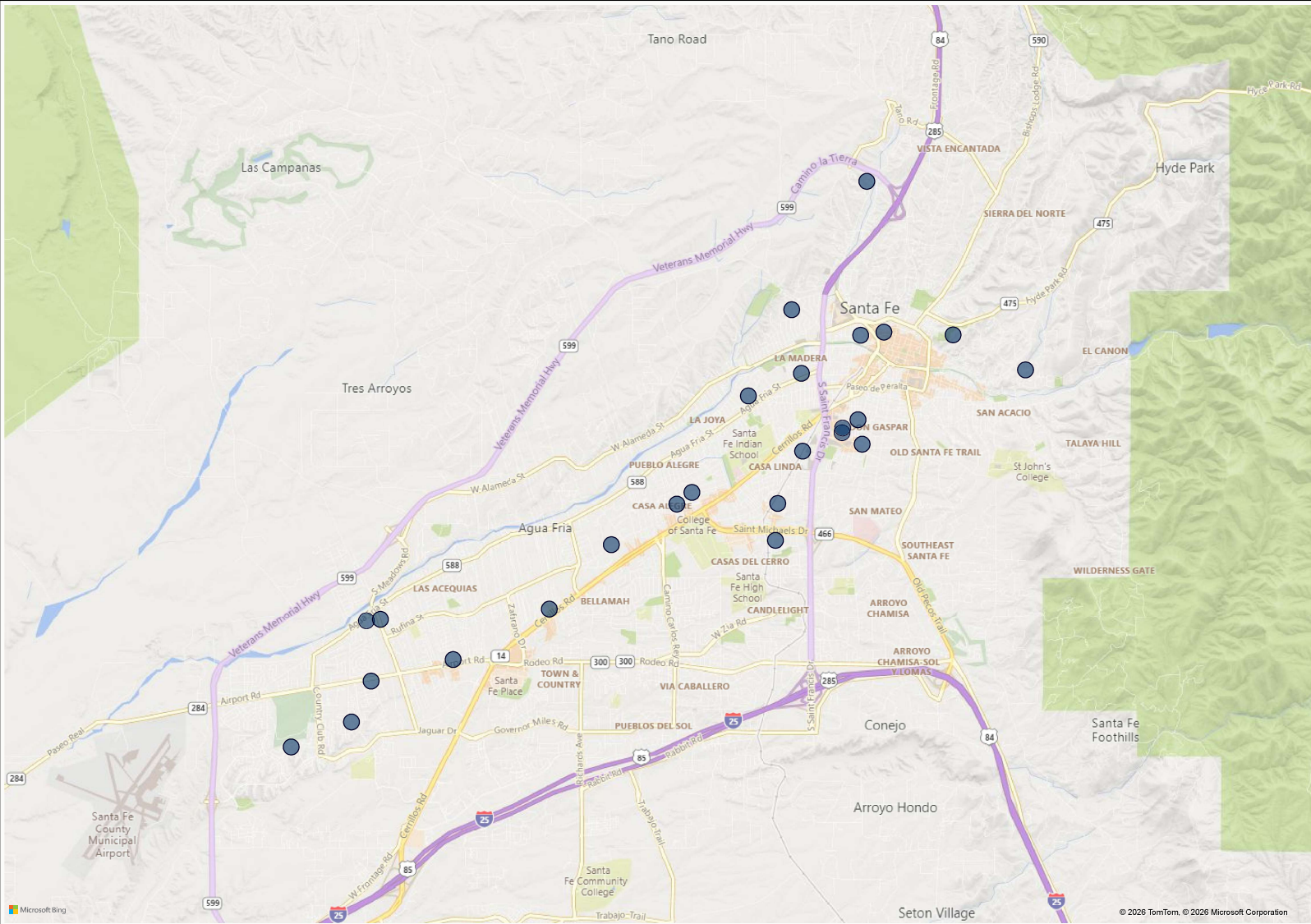

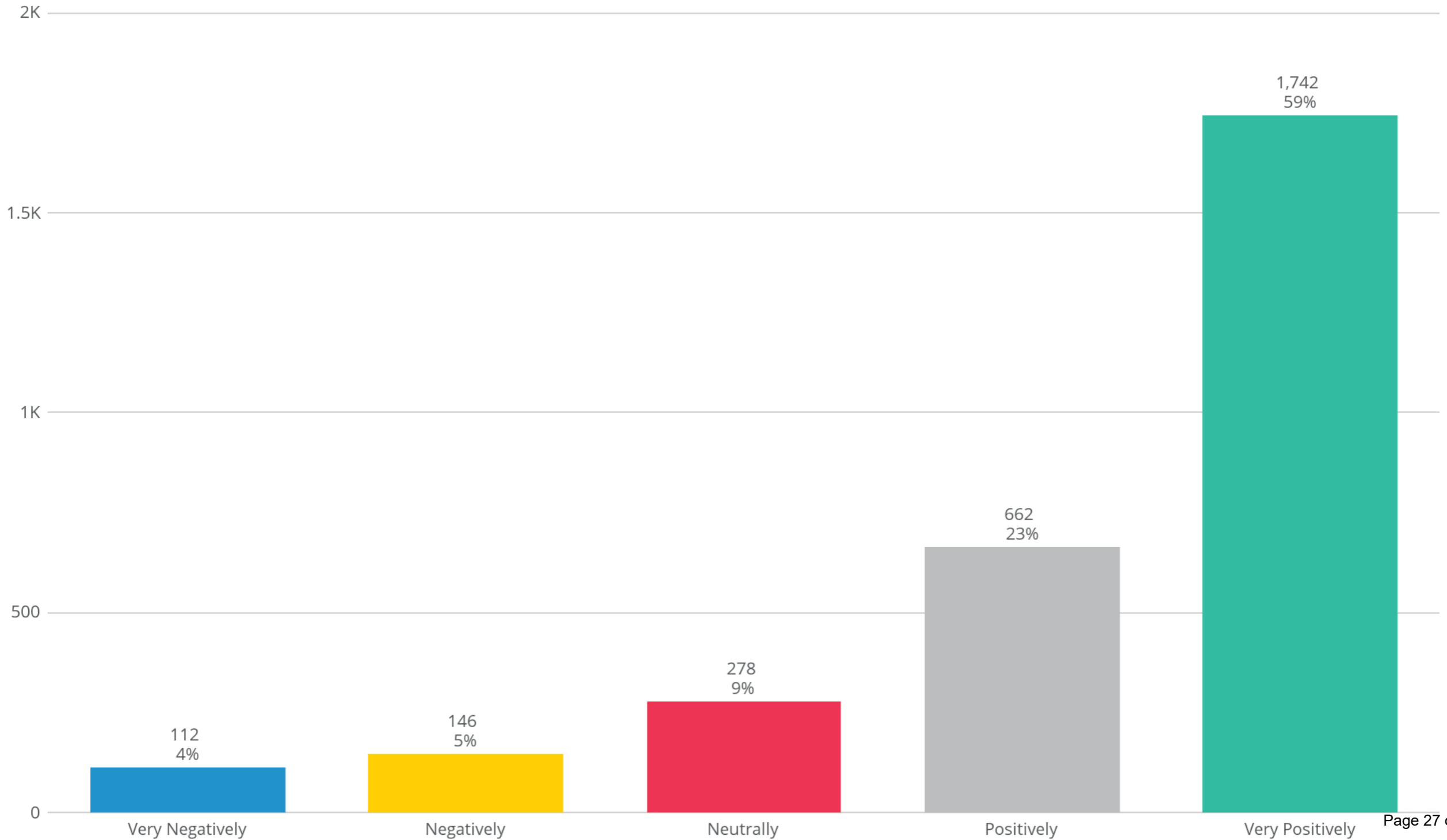

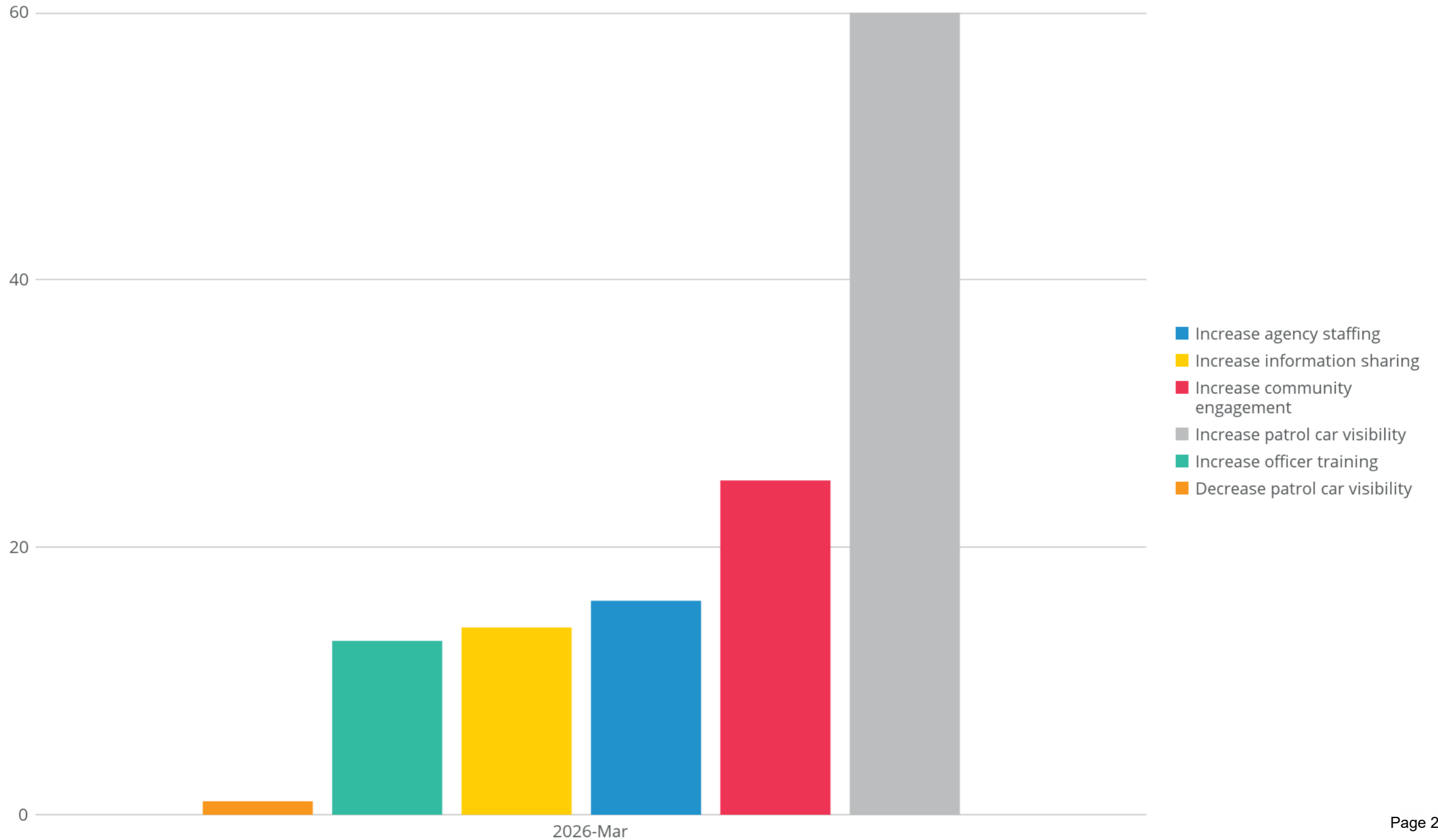

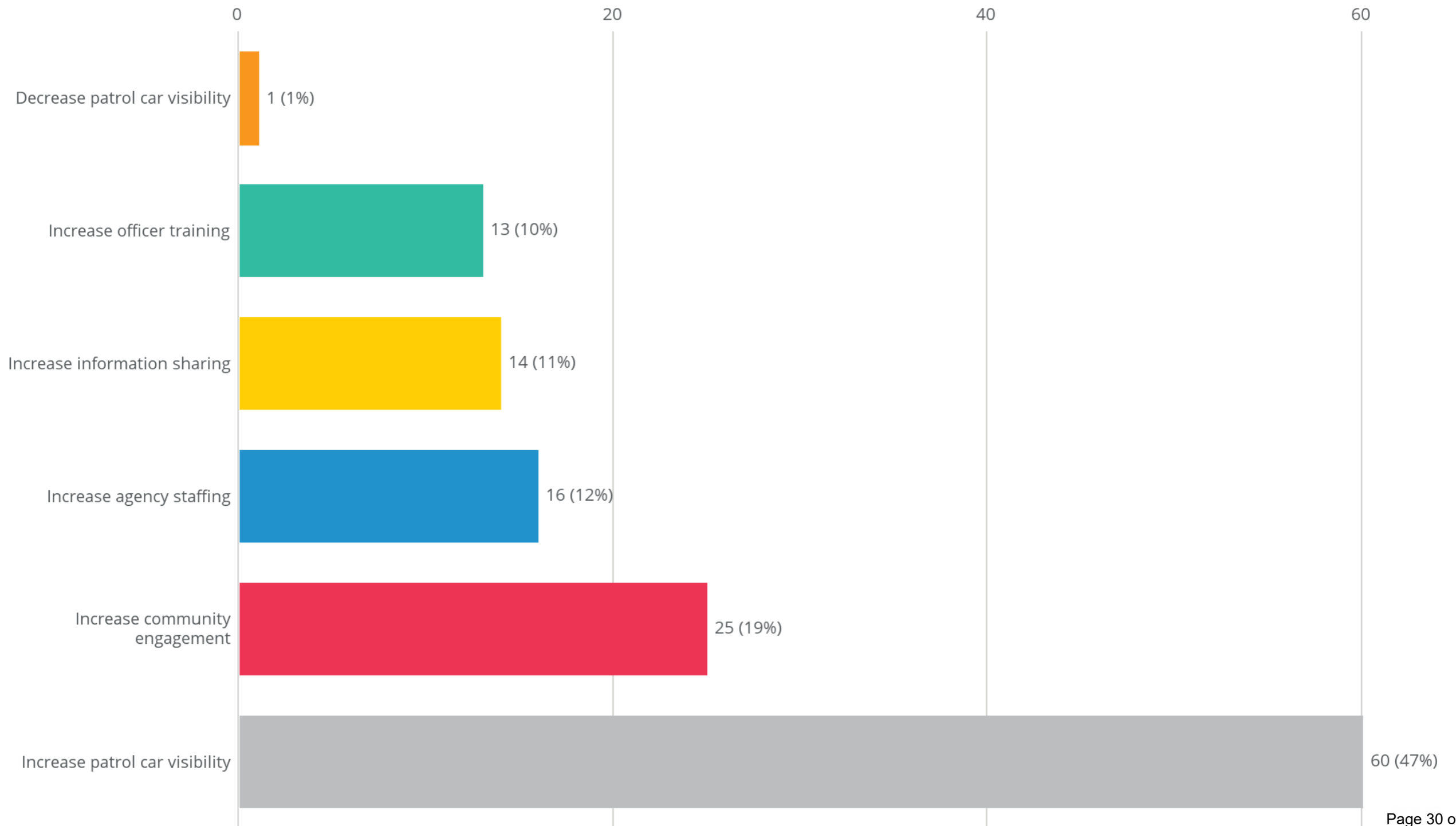

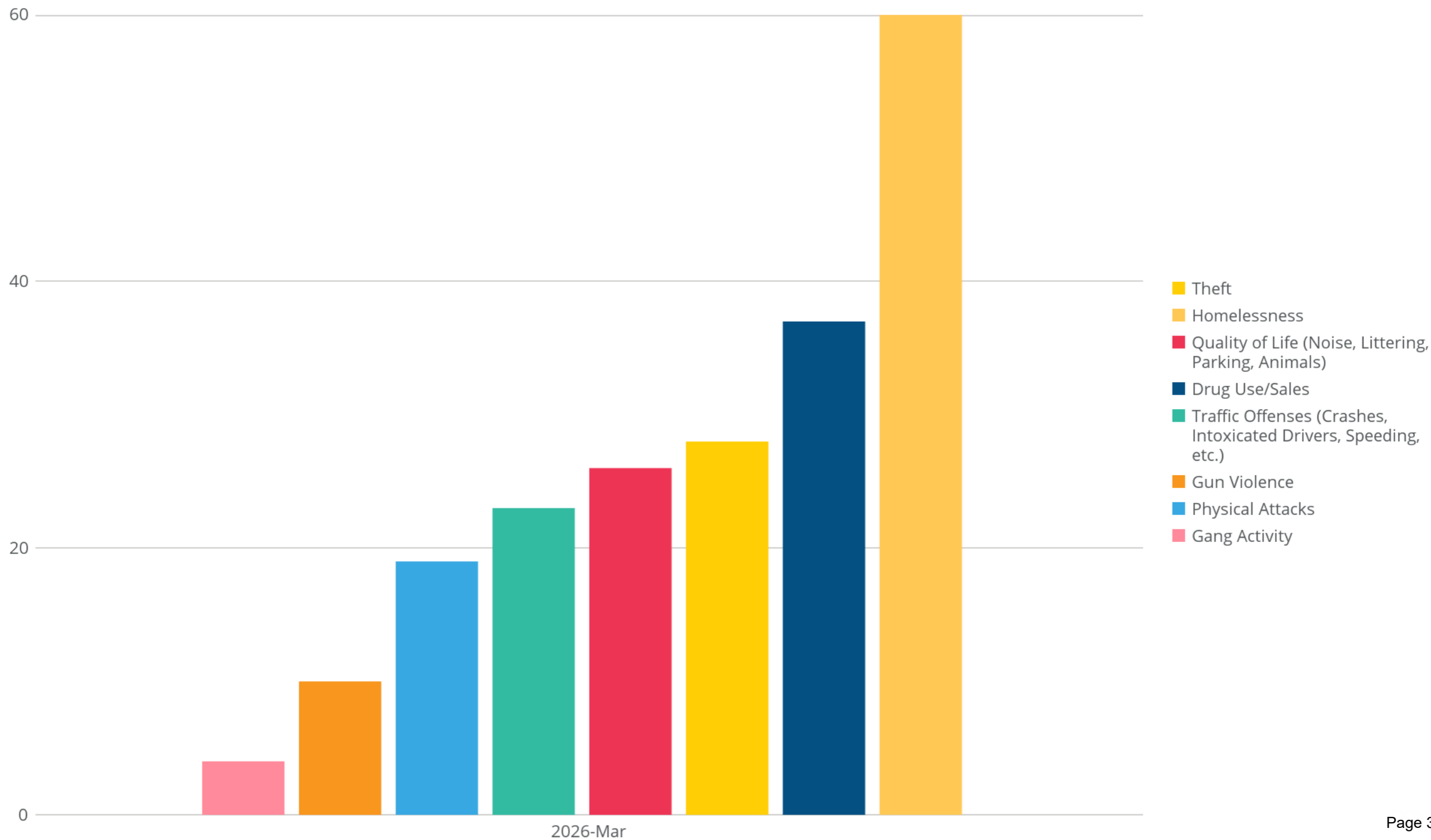
What would you most like Santa Fe PD to do to improve safety in your community?

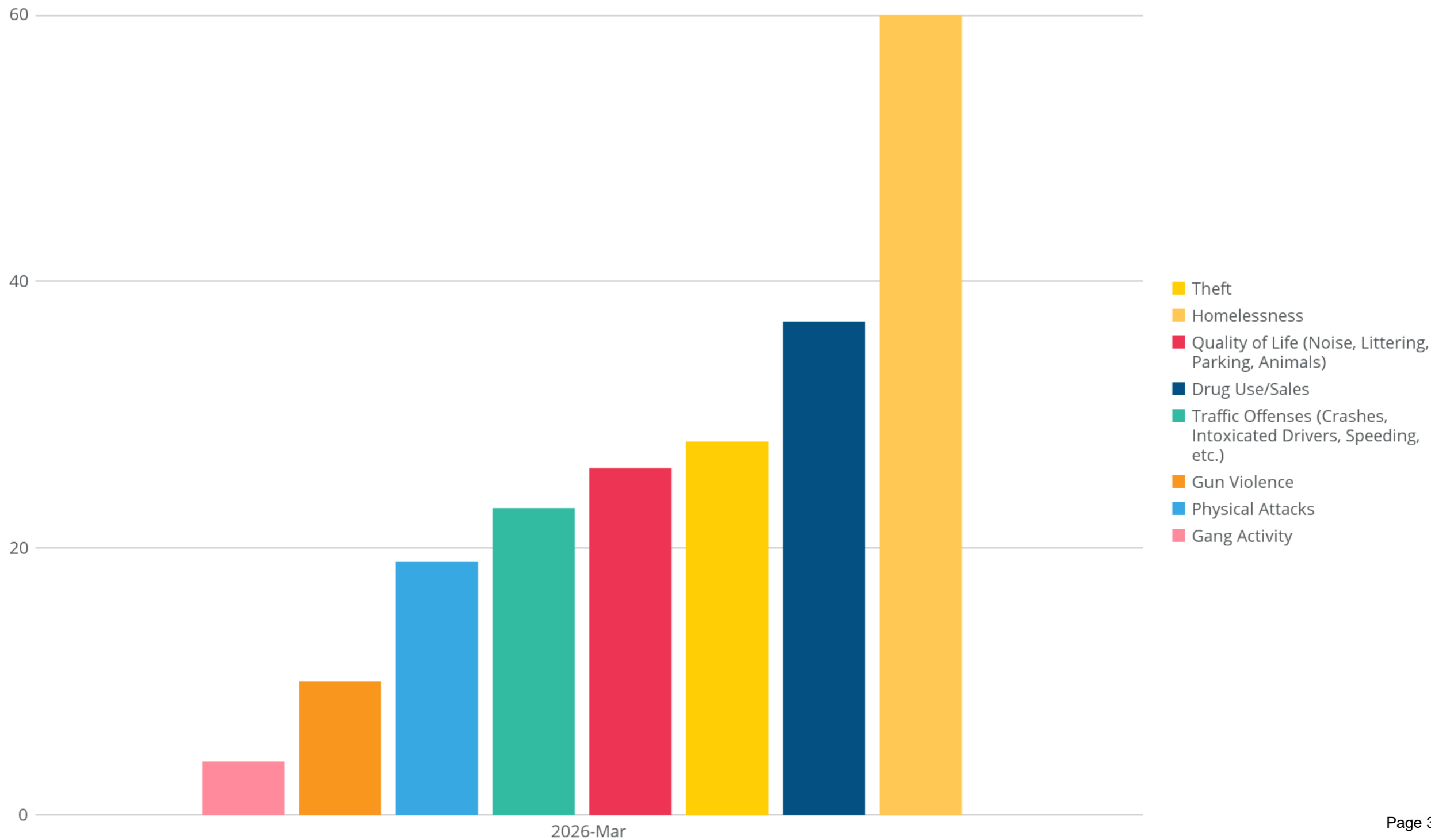

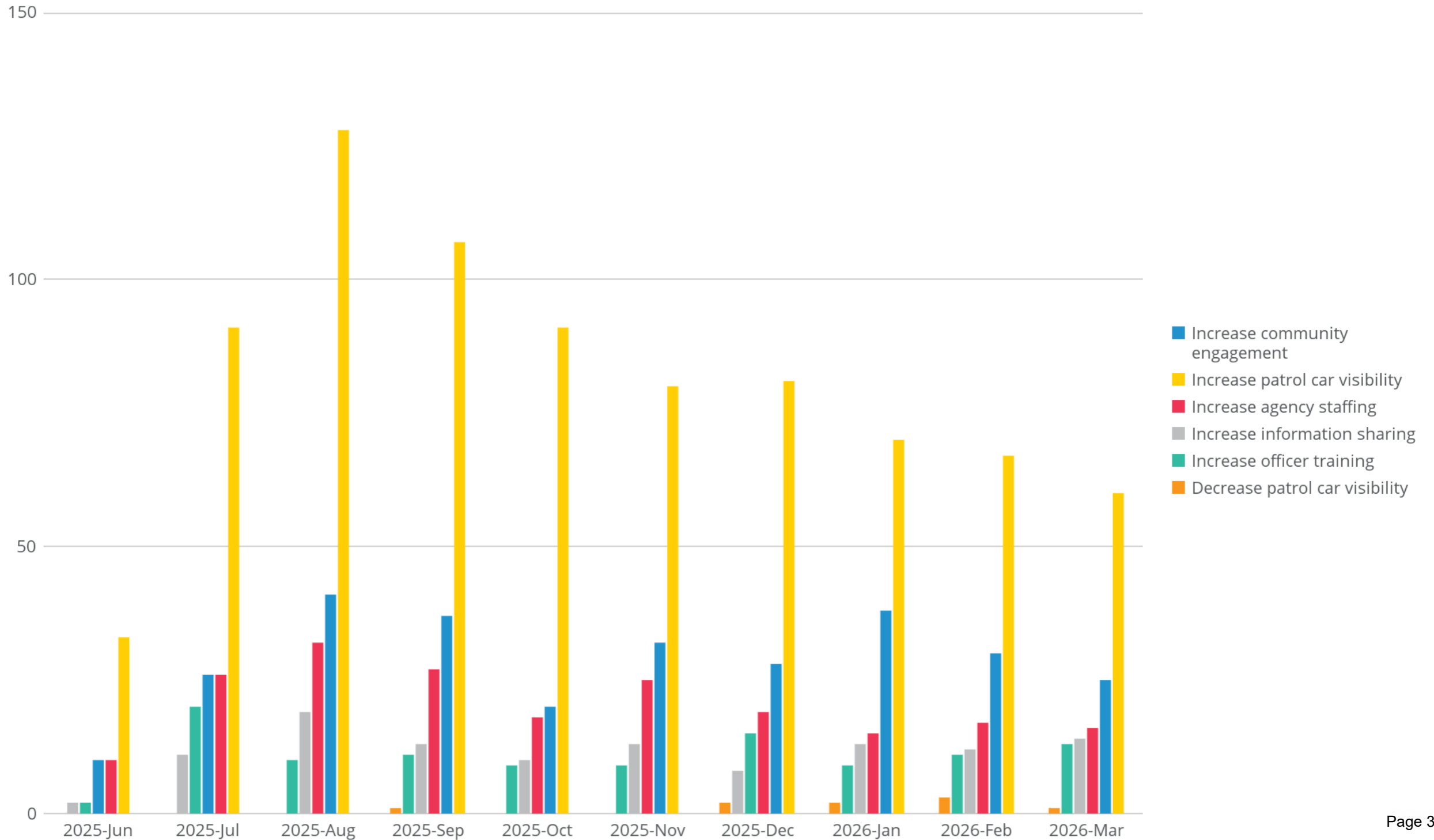


Month to Month Comparison

June 2025- March 2026

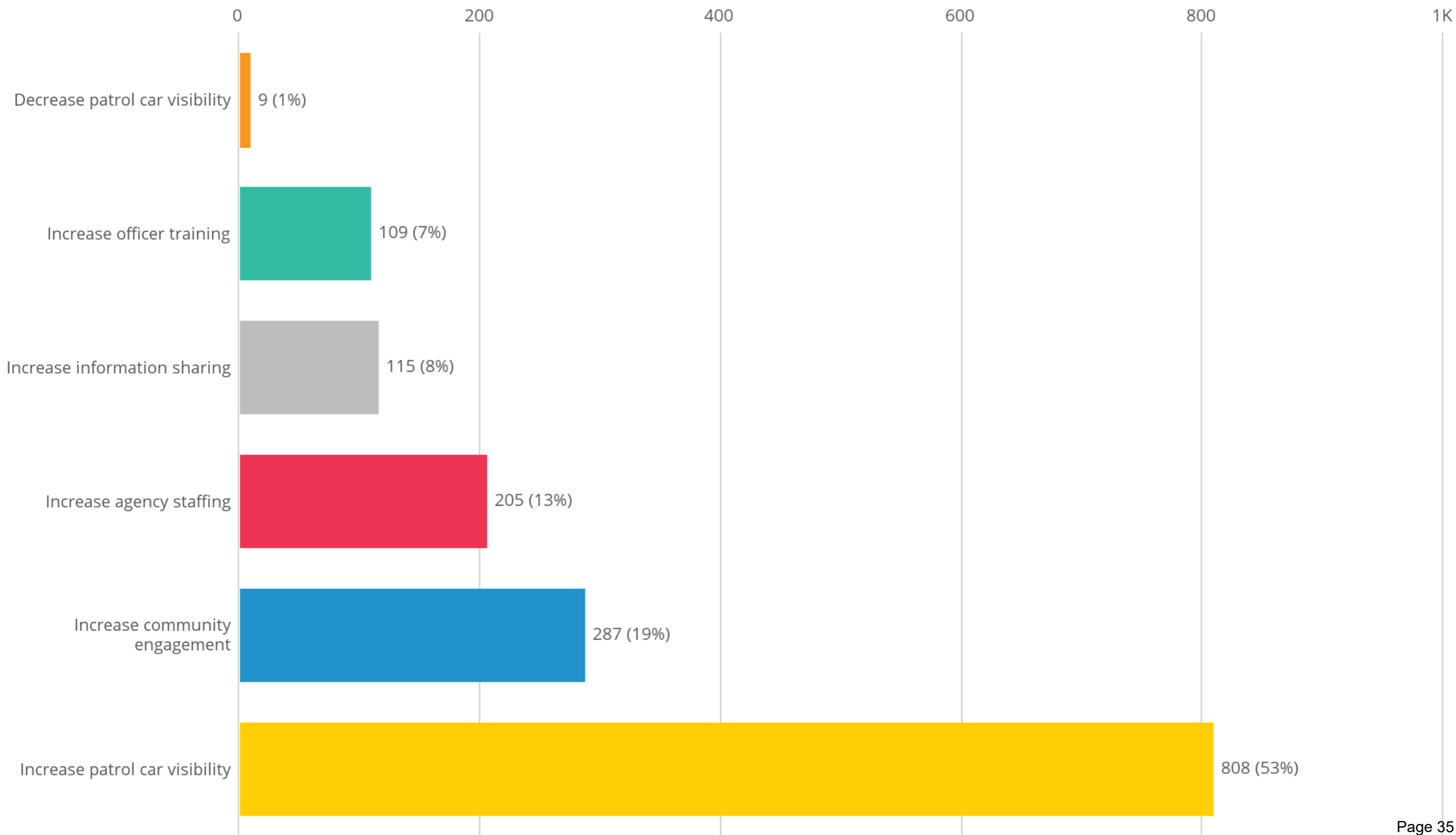

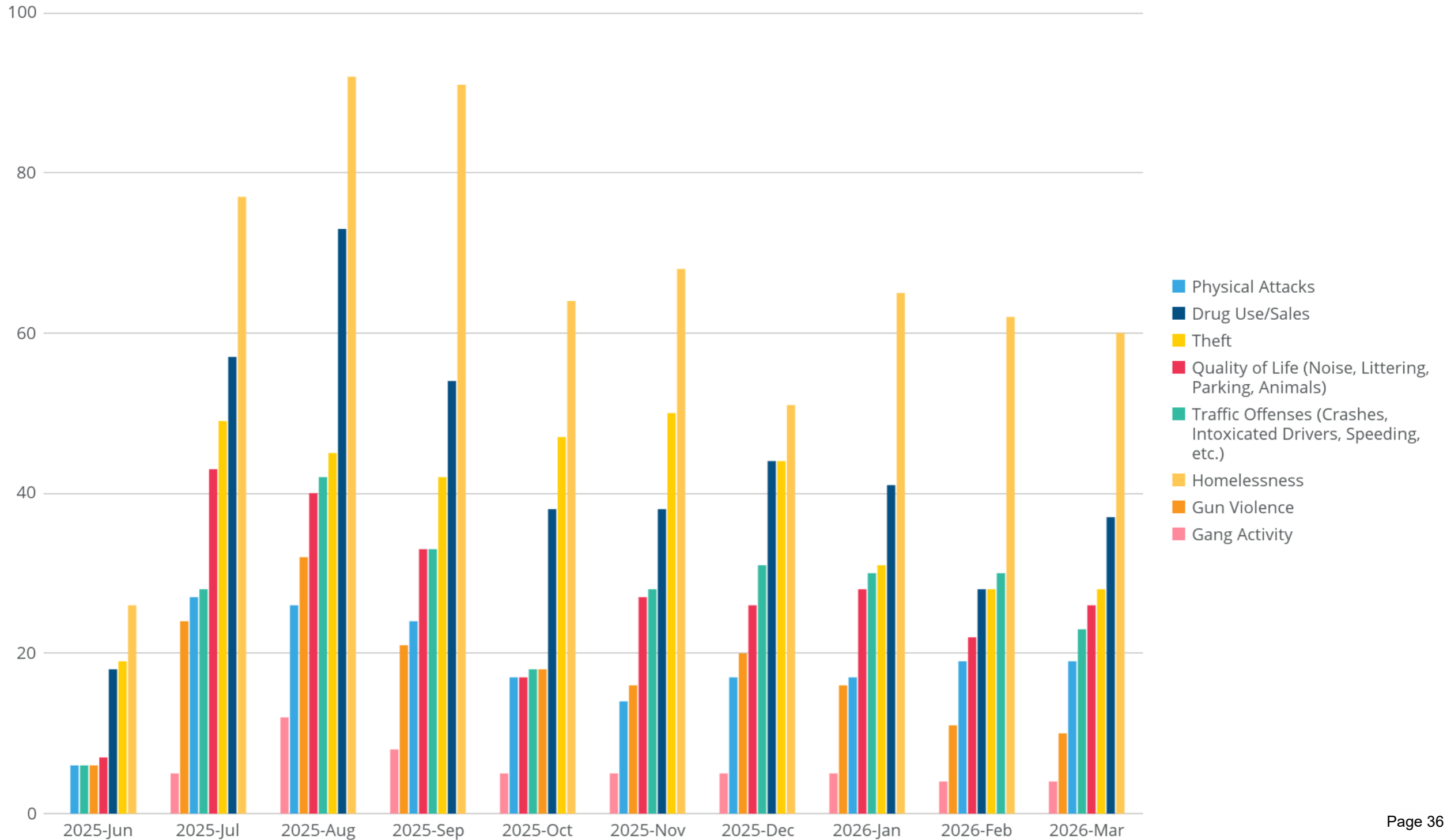
