8. ACTION ITEMS: DISCUSSION AGENDA

A. CONSIDERATION OF BILL NO. 2026-6. ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2026-_____. A BILL APPROVING THE GROUND LEASE AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT OF A CITY-OWNED BUILDING, THE MIDTOWN VISUAL ARTS CENTER, WITH MIDTOWN ARTS AND DESIGN ALLIANCE, LLC.

Ms. Venditti presented Bill No. 2026-6 including the market-rate lease, the gas line status and options.

Ms. Blosser gave a PowerPoint presentation from the Midtown Arts and Design Alliance that included the time line, shared vision, proposal benefits, necessary remediation, the development process, costs, the City's financial contribution, financing and a phased approach.

There was discussion regarding financing, concepts, Phase 1, permitting, and development plans.

Phillip Gesue. Mr. Gesue stated that he would like to be part of the solution regarding infrastructure on the campus. We applied for an ally near the Innovation Hub and are seeking public funds through Senator Wirth to open up the campus and parking. We are also engaging in fundraising regarding paving a road in front of the Hub. Senator Wirth was completely supportive of this request. We would like to work together.

Ms. Venditti said we are meeting with the Hub and the Mayor on to discuss this further. We are working with our partners and design team to ensure the approach to this is the most economical and feasible. We want continuity as well.

Mr. Continued his discussion regarding the need to work in the infrastructure solutions right away.
